

Non-Profit Security Grant

Overview

Holy Apostles Parish and School have been awarded a Non-Profit Security Grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This grant provides funding support for physical security enhancements and technologies which may include additional security camera systems, controlled access/door systems, external lighting, and improved communication systems.

Grant Details

Holy Apostles Parish and School was awarded \$450,000 total, which includes \$150,000 per address, as noted in the following list:

- Holy Apostles Catholic School - \$150,000
- Holy Apostles Catholic Parish (Church) - \$150,000
- Holy Apostles Catholic Parish (Parish Center) - \$150,000

Project components include but are not limited to the following: additional camera systems, additional controlled access/door systems, additional external lighting, improved PA system, additions to the alarm/alert system and project consulting/processing fees. Preliminary application was awarded: 7/28/2023. RFP bid process open on or before 11/1/23 – 11/28/23. Have 12 months to use the funds (expected completion of project 12/31/2024). Project Lead is Jeff Robb with Symphony Advancement.

The Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) provides funding support for target hardening and other physical security enhancements and activities to nonprofit organizations that are at high risk of terrorist attack. The intent is to integrate nonprofit preparedness activities with broader state and local preparedness efforts. It is also designed to promote coordination and collaboration in emergency preparedness activities among public and private community representatives, as well as state and local government agencies.
