School

Academically, our students have demonstrated continuous growth in their studies, demonstrating a strong work ethic and a dedication to learning. They also continue to develop a deep understanding of their faith and a commitment to living it out in their daily lives. Beyond the classroom, our students have embraced opportunities for personal and spiritual growth through participation in many projects and extracurricular activities including: food drives, adoration chapel visits, retreats, clubs, athletic teams and service projects. They have demonstrated the values of compassion, integrity, and generosity, making a positive impact on our school community and the world around them. None of this would be possible without the unwavering support of our dedicated faculty and staff, whose tireless efforts and commitment have been instrumental in shaping the lives of our students. Administrative Services: Around the Campus

Holy Apostles was approved for a safety grant in 2023-2024. Projects began around the campus including additional security cameras and door access for the church, school, and the parish center. Updated energy efficient freezers were installed in Lofy Hall and the Gym kitchen, and tuck pointing (brick work) was done on the bell tower. To ensure snow safety, snow guards were added to the church roof on the west side. We are grateful for the resources we have been blessed with to keep our campus safe and secure!

Discipleship

Jesus gave the Church the mission to "go and make disciples of all nations." This is the goal of all our discipleship programs at Holy Apostles. Our children, family and youth programs offer opportunities to build a relationship with Jesus and one another. Our goal is to help support the spiritual foundation at home so families can grow together in faith. Our formation programs begin in preschool. Children are provided with foundational Catholic teachings that instill a love for Jesus using bible stories, song, dance, and developmentally appropriate activities. Family Discipleship serves families with children grades 1-5, families have the opportunity to participate in Catholic formation through engaging, interactive activities within a group setting, working together, and building community.

Youth Discipleship grades 6-10 creates opportunities for teens to discover who Jesus is, learn how to develop their faith, to grow in community, and how to develop and nurture their relationship with God and others. New in 2024, is the grades 11-12 Youth Discipleship Program. This program is for any youth who has been confirmed or will be confirmed in October 2024. This group of young adults are invited to continue their faith journey once a month through small groups discussion, speakers, service, and other planned events. Focus is on discovering and developing their gifts and opening to how they are being called to share their gifts and talents within their families, friends, school, and faith communities. We also added, Youth Adoration Praise and Worship.
